ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Issue Date: November 7, 2005

Effective Date: November 7, 2005

On July 5, 2005, John B. Jackson filed a complaint against AmerenUE. According to the complaint, Mr. Jackson contends that "AmerenUE . . . has failed to define monetary amount or percentage if any that I am legally responsible." AmerenUE filed its answer on August 8, 2005. Staff filed a report on October 4, 2005, that stated that there appear to be no violations of any Commission rule and that AmerenUE has acted in accordance with its tariff. Mr. Jackson filed a response on October 20, 2005.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. The parties should also be prepared to name the witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing.

Also, the parties should be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

If the parties do not resolve their dispute, they shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That a prehearing conference will be held on November 17, 2005, beginning at 1:30 p.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. 2. That any party wishing to appear by telephone shall notify the Regulatory Law Judge by calling 573-522-8459 no later than 5:00 p.m., November 15, 2005.
3. That the parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule no later than November 22, 2005.
4. That this order shall become effective on November 7, 2005.
