- 3. Paragraph 2(3) of the *Order* states, "Ameren Missouri shall file with the Commission any information concerning communication with credit rating agencies concerning any such issuance."
 - 4. Ameren Missouri has completed the financing approved in the *Order*.

issuance, and asks the Commission to please accept the information out-of-time. Attachment 1 is marked confidential in its entirety.
