# ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On March 9, 2022<sup>1</sup>, the Commission issued an Order Approving Application for Financing Authority ("Order"), subject to enumerated conditions, effective March 19.

On April 29, Ameren Missouri filed a Notice of Filing Compliance Items in which it informed the Commission that it had completed the financing approved by the Order and was filing items in compliance with the conditions of the Order.

On May 4, the Commission issued its Order Directing Staff to File Recommendation on Financing Compliance in which the Commission directed its Staff to file, no later than May 13, a recommendation as to (1) whether the information in Ameren Missouri's Notice of Filing Compliance Items and the accompanying attachments comply with the Commission's Order and (2) whether this file is ready to be closed.

On May 11, Staff filed Initial Response to Order Directing Staff to File Recommendation on Financing Compliance. In its filing, Staff informed the Commission that it has submitted data requests to Ameren Missouri for which it does not expect responses until after May 13. Thus, Staff requests that it be given until June 13 to file either a recommendation or a status report.

Staff is granted an extension of time to June 13, 2022, to file a status report or a recommendation as to (1) whether the information in Ameren Missouri's *Notice of Filing Compliance Items* and the accompanying attachments comply with the Commission's *Order Approving Application for Financing Authority* issued on March 9, 2022, and (2) whether this file is ready to be closed.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
