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- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Good morning. We're on the
- 3 record.
- 4 This is the prehearing conference for Case
- 5 No. EF-2003-0465, in the matter of the application by
- 6 Aquila, Incorporated for authority to assign, transfer,
- 7 mortgage or encumber its franchise, works or system.
- 8 I am Ron Pridgin. I'm the Regulatory Law
- 9 Judge assigned by the Missouri Public Service Commission to
- 10 conduct this prehearing conference and to preside over this
- 11 case.
- We are here because of my June 12th, 2003
- 13 Order setting this case for prehearing conference. We're at
- 14 the Hotel Governor Office Building on July 1st, 2003, and
- 15 the time is ten o'clock in the morning.
- If I could, at this time I would like to get
- 17 entries of appearance from counsel, beginning with Staff,
- 18 please.
- 19 MR. WILLIAMS: Nathan Williams and Steve
- 20 Dottheim, Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri, 65102.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Williams.
- 22 Anyone here on behalf of the Office of the Public Counsel?
- 23 MR. MICHEEL: That would be me, your Honor.
- 24 Douglas E. Micheel appearing on behalf of the Office of the
- 25 Public Counsel and the public.

- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Micheel. On
- 2 behalf of Aquila?
- 3 MR. BOUDREAU: Let the record reflect the
- 4 appearance of Paul Boudreau with the law firm Brydon,
- 5 Swearengen & England, Post Office Box 456, Jefferson City,
- 6 Missouri, on behalf of applicant Aquila, Inc.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Boudreau.
- 8 I believe I also have some intervenors in this
- 9 case. On behalf of Sedalia Industrial Energy Users
- 10 Association and Ag Processing?
- 11 MR. CONRAD: Stuart W. Conrad of the law firm
- 12 Finnegan, Conrad & Peterson, 1209 Penntower, 3100 Broadway,
- 13 Kansas City, Missouri 64111.
- 14 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Conrad.
- On behalf of the State of Missouri?
- JUDGE REGISTER: Shelly Woods for Ron Molteni,
- 17 M-o-l-t-e-n-i, Post Office Box 899, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 18 65102. It's Ron Molteni, Assistant Attorney General.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Ms. Woods.
- 20 And I believe I also have a pending motion for
- 21 intervention from KCP&L which was filed on June 26th. Is
- 22 anyone here on behalf of KCP&L?
- MR. FISCHER: Yes, your Honor. James M.
- 24 Fischer, Fischer & Dority, P.C., 101 Madison Street,
- 25 Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101, appearing on

- 1 behalf of Kansas City Power & Light.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Fischer. As
- 3 I'm sure the parties know, I've not yet ruled on this
- 4 application to intervene. The ten days to reply has not yet
- 5 run. Do any of the parties know right now whether or not
- 6 they would object to that application?
- 7 MR. CONRAD: We do, your Honor, and we will
- 8 have no objection.
- 9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Any other parties have any
- 10 input on that?
- MR. BOUDREAU: I suspect that we are going to
- 12 be filing something opposing the intervention, and I'll try
- 13 to do that as quickly as possible.
- 14 JUDGE PRIDGIN: That's fine. As long as I
- 15 know at least one party potentially objects, I certainly
- 16 won't rule on that application for now. Mr. Williams?
- 17 MR. WILLIAMS: Judge, Staff has no objections
- 18 to that intervention.
- 19 JUDGE PRIDGIN: I believe the ten days would
- 20 run July 6, which would be Sunday, so that would give it
- 21 until the 7th to file if anybody has any objections, and
- 22 then we'll rule on that from that.
- 23 Because KCP&L may or may not be a party, do
- 24 any of the parties have any objection to at least including
- 25 KCP&L in with your settlement discussions, realizing that

- 1 they may or may not ultimately be a party?
- MR. BOUDREAU: I have no objection with one
- 3 caveat. If we get into speaking about confidential
- 4 information, which is not likely today, in all frankness,
- 5 we'll have to among ourselves figure out how to work that
- 6 out.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: That's fine.
- 8 MR. BOUDREAU: With that exception.
- 9 JUDGE PRIDGIN: Thank you, Mr. Boudreau. Any
- 10 other qualms with at least letting KCP&L in on your
- 11 discussions for now?
- 12 (No response.)
- 13 Okay. Obviously the main purpose for having
- 14 the prehearing conference is to make sure we get all the
- 15 parties and potential parties in one room to hopefully iron
- 16 out your differences and, if not, to come up with a proposed
- 17 procedural schedule. I believe that is due July 9th. I
- 18 built in an extra day to cover for the July 4th holiday.
- 19 If anybody has any kind of questions or
- 20 concerns as far as times, when I would be available, when
- 21 the Commission would be available, I'm available up on the
- 22 9th Floor. We have a calendar there by Judge Roberts'
- 23 office if anybody wants to consult as far as dates.
- I have no idea what kind of time frame you're
- 25 looking at, but just in case, if I can let everyone know, I

- 1 will be unavailable the week of August 25th. I'm not
- 2 suggesting that you would necessarily be ready by then, but
- 3 just in case, I didn't want everybody to say, hey, that
- 4 would be a great week and me say, well, that's terrible for
- 5 me, go back and try again.
- 6 That is in no way trying to say that I expect
- 7 you to have anything ready. I just wanted to let you know
- 8 off the top of my head.
- 9 MR. MICHEEL: You don't have to worry about
- 10 that date, your Honor.
- JUDGE PRIDGIN: I didn't think so, but I
- 12 thought just in case.
- I don't think I have any other pending
- 14 motions. Is there anything else that any of the parties
- 15 would like to bring to my attention at this time?
- MR. WILLIAMS: Judge, I'll just point out that
- 17 the Staff has circulated a proposed schedule. We haven't
- 18 gotten back from all the parties. And the hearing dates we
- 19 were looking at were late October.
- 20 JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. Very good. Thank
- 21 you, Mr. Williams.
- 22 Anything else that the parties would like to
- 23 bring to my attention?
- 24 (No response.)
- 25 All right. Hearing nothing, you have access
