STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC (Applicant), a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in the service areas of Spectra Communications Group, LLC, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., Sprint Missouri, Inc., and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC conditioned upon certain access rate provisions. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo 2000.)
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 2000.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 2000.)
- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the *Application*. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the

Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.185, 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 2000.)

4. The Applicant did not submit a tariff with its application. Pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(c), a tariff must be filed before service can be provided.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC, a certificate to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services in the service areas described above, conditioned upon the access rate provisions described in the Staff memorandum; grant Applicant competitive classification; and approve the waivers listed in the Application for Certification of Service Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange Telecommunications Service and for Competitive Classification.
