On October 13, 2009, Velocity The Greatest Phone Company Ever, Inc. applied for certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service and for competitive classification. The Commission issued notice of Velocity's application and established October 28 as the deadline for the filing of applications to intervene. No party has requested intervention.

On October 29, the Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation regarding Velocity's application by November 17. On November 18, Staff filed a motion explaining that it has been unable to file its recommendation because Velocity needs to file certain documents to complete its application. Staff asks the Commission to extend the filing date for Staff's recommendation to December 2.

Staff's request for more time is reasonable and the Commission will grant that request.
