ORDER RE-CLASSIFYING COMPLAINT

The Commission is re-classifying the complaint¹ from protected (“proprietary”) to unprotected (“public”). The Commission proposed to re-classify the complaint.² The complainants³ and respondent⁴ each filed a response.

The current classification of the complaint is proprietary.

Proprietary information is information concerning trade secrets,
as well as confidential or private technical, financial, and
business information.[⁵]
