On October 9, 2014, the complainant filed the complaint. Respondent filed an Answer and Motion to Dismiss on November 13.

The Commission ordered its Staff to conduct an investigation and file a Recommendation no later than December 22. On December 15, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time. In its motion, Staff explains that Respondent and Staff are awaiting responses to data requests, and that Staff needs until January 29, 2015 to file a response.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.
