ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

Issue Date: December 20, 2017

Effective Date: December 20, 2017

William L. Gehrs, Jr. filed the complaint,¹ charging that The Empire District Electric Company (“Empire District”) “has failed to uniformly assess multiple customer charge fees to multi-unit apartment buildings in the Joplin Missouri area [.]”² Bob Higginbotham (“Mr. Higginbotham”) filed an application for intervention (“motion”).³ The Commission received no response to the motion within the time provided by regulation.⁴ The Commission convened a procedural conference,⁵ at which Empire District stated that it has no objection, and Staff made no objection.

The motion is subject to the following standard:

The commission may on application permit any person to intervene on a showing that—

(A) The proposed intervenor has an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case; or

(B) Granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest [.]

The motion alleges that Mr. Higginbotham owns a multi-unit property in Joplin, Missouri. That interest in a building, of the classification for which billing is at issue in the complaint, is different from that of the general public. And that interest is subject to an adverse effect from the decision on the complaint.

The Commission will grant the motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. *Application to Intervene of Bob Higginbotham* is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
