## ORDER DIRECTING FILING AND ORDERS FOR A SMALL COMPLAINT

The Commission is granting the *Motion to Request Status Change* ("motion"). <sup>1</sup> The motion asks the Commission to apply the Commission's small formal complaint procedures. <sup>2</sup> The Commission took up the motion at the May 2, 2018 conference <sup>3</sup> and no party objected.
