NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

On October 19, 2004, Spigel Properties filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE. Spigel alleged that AmerenUE demanded payment for arrears that resulted from AmerenUE under-billing Spigel.

The Commission held prehearing conferences in March and July of 2005. Thereafter, the parties filed a joint notice dismissing the complaint with prejudice. In the notice, the parties informed the Commission that a settlement of \$60,862.89 had been reached.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that a complainant may voluntarily dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence offered. There has been no testimony filed or evidence offered in this matter. Therefore, the complaint is dismissed with prejudice and this case may be closed.
