ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On April 6, 2006, the Commission issued its Report and Order clarifying who should pay for certain improvements to Kansas City Power & Light Company's facilities pursuant to the approved General Development Plan. On April 14, 2006, Boulevard Brewing Company filed an Application for Rehearing or Reconsideration.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, provides that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefore shall be made to appear." The Commission finds that Boulevard Brewing Company has failed to establish sufficient reason to grant its application. The Commission will deny the

application.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Boulevard Brewing Company's Application for Rehearing or Reconsideration is denied.

2. This order shall become effective on May 25, 2006.
