ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Issue Date: January 7, 2008 Effective Date: January 17, 2008

Leesa Forsee filed a formal complaint against Aquila, Inc., on April 9, 2007. Ms. Forsee's complaint alleges that Aquila incorrectly placed a deposit charge on her bill, and that Aquila owes her approximately \$70 due to that improper charge. Aquila denies her allegations.

On September 11, 2007, Aquila filed a Motion to Suspend Time for Filing Proposed Procedural Schedule. Aquila explained that the parties have resolved their dispute, and that once the parties finalized their agreement, Ms. Forsee would dismiss her complaint. The Commission granted Aquila's motion.

No party has filed any pleading in this case since Aquila's September 11, 2007 motion. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(2) allows for cases to be dismissed if no action has occurred for 90 days and no party has filed a pleading requesting a continuance beyond that time. This case has been inactive for more than 90 days, and no party has

filed a pleading requesting a continuance beyond that time, presumably because Ms. Forsee and Aquila have resolved their dispute. Therefore, unless a party objects before the January 17, 2008 effective date of this order, the Commission will dismiss the complaint.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. As permitted by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(2), Leesa L. Forsee's complaint against Aquila, Inc., is dismissed.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on January 17, 2008.
 - 3. This case shall be closed on January 18, 2008.
