ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 29, 2005, Matrix Telecom, Inc., filed an application for a Certificate of Service Authority to provide basic local telecommunications service. In paragraph 4 of the application, the company states it that proposes to provide service in those areas currently being served by "Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), GTE d/b/a Verizon, or Spectra. The specific SWBT, Sprint, Verizon or Spectra exchanges within which Matrix proposes to offer service"

Because Sprint is not mentioned in the first sentence, the Commission will require that Matrix file a pleading clarifying which exchanges it proposes to offer service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Matrix Telecom, Inc., shall file not later than May 13, 2005, a clearer statement setting forth the exchanges in which it proposes to offer telecommunications service.

2. That this order shall become effective on May 3, 2005.
