Ameren Missouri Residential Energy Efficiency Program

General Eligibility Information

- The equipment used must be the program's eligibility requirements based on quality for the rebate. Please contact the eligibility of your system with a Participating Contractor.
- The equipment to be installed must be a current, factory, American-manufactured electric equipment.
- To be eligible for participation in the program, the building unit must be the site of the following:
 - Single-family residence
 - Building with four units or fewer, in any configuration
 - New home which is defined as a single-family building unit that does not contain rental units with other single-family building units
 - Existing multifamily building units with greater than four units that also does a horizontal surface floor or ceiling with another building unit

Single Family Eligibility

- A Participating Contractor must install qualifying equipment and that contractor must be certified by Participating Contractors for the Heating and Cooling Program at the time of installation. Participating Contractors can be located by visiting www.AmerenMissouriSavings.com/HVAC or calling 1-877-275-5752. When you visit the Participating Contractor, mention that you are interested in the Ameren Missouri rebates.
- All rebate applications and supporting documents must be submitted by a Participating Contractor within 30 days of installation and by December 31, 2022.

Multifamily Eligibility

- Single-family building units with greater than four units that also does a horizontal surface floor or ceiling with another building unit

New Equipment Rebate Eligibility

- Energy management system used and/or used the National Energy Efficiency Rating (NEER) or Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) by both we built by the program and distributed by the Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI).
- Existing operating CAC and GSHP using updated heat loss or sensible SEER rating of **13.0 or higher** **13.0 or higher**

What are the eligibility criteria for this program?

The equipment must meet the program's eligibility requirements listed here to qualify for the rebate.

- The dwelling must be associated with a current Ameren Missouri residential electric account.
- To be eligible for participation in the program, the dwelling unit must be one of the following:
 - Single-Family Eligibility
 - Single-family residence
 - Building with four units or fewer, in any configuration
 - Row house, which is defined as a single-family dwelling unit that shares common vertical walls only with other single-family dwelling units
 - Multi-Family Eligibility
 - Multistory, multi-family dwelling units with greater than four units that also share a horizontal surface (floor or ceiling) with another dwelling unit
- A Participating Contractor must install the qualifying equipment and that contractor must be considered a Participating Contractor by the Heating and Cooling program at the time of installation. Participating Contractors can be located by visiting [AmerenMissouriSavings.com/hvac](https://www.amerenmissourisavings.com/hvac) or calling 1.877.215.5752.
- All rebate applications and supporting documents must be submitted by a participating contractor within 30 days of service and by December 15, ~~2021~~.
- Newly installed equipment must meet or exceed the Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) or Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) levels set forth by the program and documented by the Air Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI).
- Existing operating CAC and ASHP being replaced must have a nameplate SEER rating of ~~12~~ **13.99** or lower.
- Existing operating GSHP being replaced must have a nameplate EER rating of 12 or lower (partial cooling load).
- Existing failed CAC, ASHP or GSHP does not require maximum nameplate SEER/EER rating.
- ~~Existing equipment that is operating must produce a temperature drop across the coil to be classified as early replacement. If the outside temperature is below 65 degrees, the Participating Contractor must verify that the compressor is operational.~~
- Rebate eligibility is dependent on the existing heating source.
- New Construction Rebate Eligibility
 - Newly installed equipment must meet or exceed the Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) or Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) levels set forth by the program above and documented by the Air-Conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI).
- Contractor Eligibility and Participation
 - All interested contractors are required to attend program orientation and complete a contractor participation agreement prior to offering Ameren Missouri rebates.
 - Rebate applications and supporting documentation are submitted by contractors on behalf of customers.
