ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Doug and Nancy Geno filed a formal complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, on May 7, 2009.¹ AmerenUE filed its Answer and Motion to Dismiss on June 10. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a verified report concerning the complaint no later than June 26.

On June 22, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff alluded to safety concerns which requires it to make an on-site visit and to send data requests. As a consequence, Staff requested an extension of time until July 31 to submit its report. The Commission granted that request

On July 28, Staff filed another Motion for Extension of Time. Staff stated that AmerenUE provided Staff the information it needed on July 28, and that Staff needs until August 31 to review that information and file a recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a verified report concerning the above-referenced complaint no later than August 31, 2009.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
