ORDER ESTABLISHING REQUIREMENTS FOR EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Issue Date: September 20, 2011 Effective Date: September 20, 2011

On September 6, 2011, the Commission set an evidentiary hearing for October 31, 2011. The Commission will direct the parties regarding the preparation for the hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. All parties tendering witnesses at the evidentiary hearing shall file a statement disclosing the identity and biographical background of those witnesses no later than October 17, 2011.
- 2. No later than October 17, 2011, the parties shall agree upon, and Staff shall file, a list of the witnesses to appear: the order in which they will be called; and the order of party cross-examination for each witness.
- 3. The parties shall pre-number their hearing exhibits sequentially with individual party designation as exemplified below:
 - a.) Vickers Exhibit No. 1, Vickers Exhibit No. 2, Vickers Exhibit No. 3, etc.
 - b.) Ameren Missouri Exhibit No. 1, Ameren Missouri Exhibit No. 2, Ameren Missouri Exhibit No. 3, etc.

c.) OPC Exhibit No. 1, OPC Exhibit No. 2, OPC Exhibit No. 3, etc.

d.) Staff Exhibit No. 1, Staff Exhibit No. 2, Staff Exhibit No. 3, etc.

4. Each party shall prepare a comprehensive exhibit list of their own exhibits before

the evidentiary hearing with the listed exhibits numbered sequentially as directed in

paragraph 3. Copies of the exhibit lists shall be provided to the Commissioners, the

Regulatory Law Judge and the Court Reporter at the beginning of hearing.

5. All parties shall bring an adequate number of copies of exhibits that they intend

to offer into evidence at the hearing. If an exhibit has not been prefiled, the party offering it

must bring, in addition to the copy for the court reporter, copies for the five Commissioners,

the Presiding Judge, and all counsel.

6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
