ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING

Issue Date: April 11, 2012 Effective Date: April 11, 2012

On March 7, 2012, the Commission issued a Report and Order regarding Briarcliff Development Company's (Briarcliff) complaint against Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCP&L). That Report and Order became effective on April 6, 2012. On April 5, 2012, both Briarcliff and KCP&L filed applications for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo 2000, states that the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Briarcliff and KCP&L raise some of the same arguments in their applications for rehearing that the Commission rejected in its Report and Order. The Commission will not revisit those arguments. KCP&L asserts that that it will be injured by Briarcliff receiving the all-electric rate due to possible litigation in some other venue, but this alleged injury is

speculative and not based on facts in evidence. Briarcliff and KCP&L's applications for rehearing fail to provide sufficient reason to grant rehearing and will be denied.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Application for Rehearing filed by Briarcliff Development Company is denied.
- 2. The Application for Rehearing filed by Kansas City Power & Light Company is denied.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
