ORDER ESTABLISHING A RESPONSE DEADLINE

On April 10, 2012, the Commission’s Staff filed a motion requesting the Commission order Complainants to show cause why this complaint should not be dismissed for failure to state a claim upon which this Commission may grant relief. Staff’s motion alleges that, based upon the allegations in the complaint, there is no effective relief the Commission can grant to the Complainants and that dismissal may be appropriate if the doctrines of administrative exhaustion and futility have been satisfied. The Commission will set a deadline for responses.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than April 20, 2012, Complainants shall respond to Staff’s motion. Complainants shall address Staff’s arguments regarding the jurisdiction and authority of this Commission with particularity.
2. Any other party that wishes to respond to Staff’s motion may file said response no later than April 20, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
