On August 31, 2011, the Commission received a complaint from Mr. Small. On October 5, 2011, the Commission issued an Order Dismissing Parties and Claims. That order dismissed all the parties save for Ameren Missouri, and dismissed all of Mr. Small's claims for legal, equitable and class action relief. That order became effective October 15, 2011.¹

That same order stated that the Staff believes the Commission has authority to hear a complaint against Ameren Missouri on whether it has discriminated against Mr. Small. Given that the Commission has already ruled that it has no authority to grant legal, equitable, or class action relief, the parties shall state what remedy, if any, the Commission has authority to grant Mr. Small in the event he prevails in his complaint.
