Dear Mr. Woodruff:

I am writing to ask that you ask your clients Ameren Union Electric Company to stop making threats against me regarding my high utility bill. I am in the process of drafting a pleading under Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (FRCP) Rule 65 for a Motion for Injunctive Relief. Mr. Kevin Thompson from your office indicated that Ameren could not be harassing me while the hearing process was in order.

A disconnection will cause the following problems:

- 1. My apartment is totally electric. I have no way of cooking food if my electricity is turned off.
- 2. I am a person with a disability and I use medical equipment requiring electricity to ambulate.
- 3. I suffer from depression because the way the utility companies have stressed me out with their treats.
- 4. I am on the Section Eight Program and they require that all utilities be in use or the lease is null and void. I will need someplace to live if my utilities are turned off.
- 5. I have tried to pay on the bill even after an agreement was made and the agreement was to pay \$164.00 earlier this summer. My bill ended up being \$600.00 which I am disputing in the hearing.

6. I try to pay \$40.00 a month since I am a beneficiary of the Social Security Administration (SSA). I receive Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI). I try not to use any electricity unless absolutely necessary.

I am urging you to take some action and put in writing as soon as possible. In the meantime I will be drafting a Motion for Injunctive Relief under FRCP Rule 65. I will do this as soon as possible. My Dragon Naturally Speaking is not operational at this time. I am writing this letter with one hand. I am asking that you get in touch with me as soon as possible. I look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience.
