ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Issue Date: May 28, 2014 Effective Date: June 27, 2014

Timothy Watson filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Generally, Mr. Watson complains that Ameren Missouri is wrongfully holding him responsible for an electric bill at his rental property. Complainant requests that service be restored so that he can rent the property.

Ameren Missouri filed its answer and moved that the complaint be dismissed.

Ameren Missouri states that although Complainant remains responsible for the bill, service has been restored and the issue is moot.

Upon the motion to dismiss, the Commission directed Complainant to file a response and to inform the Commission of whether the complaint has been satisfied. Complainant failed to respond.

Thereafter, the company filed a second motion to dismiss, informing the Commission that Complainant has not responded to messages and pointing out Complainant's failure to

respond to the Commission's order. On April 15, 2014, the Commission issued a second order directing Complainant to respond to the company's motions by May 2, 2014. In that order, the Commission informed Complainant that failure to respond to a Commission order may result in this complaint being dismissed. Complainant again failed to respond.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3) states that a party may be dismissed for failure to respond to a Commission order. Complainant has twice failed to respond to Commission orders. The Commission will therefore dismiss this complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. This complaint is dismissed.
- 2. This order shall become effective on June 27, 2014.
- 3. This file shall be closed on June 28, 2014.
