**ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

Issue Date: February 25, 2015

Effective Date: March 27, 2015

On October 9, 2014, Danielle Mehlenbacher (“Complainant”) filed the complaint. Respondent filed an Answer and Motion to Dismiss on November 13, 2014.

Staff filed a Recommendation on January 29, 2015, stating that the Commission does not have authority to award the damages that Complainant seeks. Staff further states that the Commission should dismiss the complaint so that the parties may resolve their dispute in court without additional expense or delay.

On February 3, 2015, the Commission ordered Complainant to state whether she wishes to continue to pursue her complaint at the Commission. That order notified Complainant that she had until February 13, 2015 to respond, and that failure to respond could result in the Commission dismissing the complaint. Complainant failed to respond.

The Commission's regulations provide:

A party may be dismissed from a case for failure to comply with any order issued by the commission.<sup>1</sup>

Therefore, the Commission will dismiss the complaint.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The complaint is dismissed.
2. This order shall become effective on March 27, 2015.
3. This file shall be closed on March 28, 2015.
