**SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE, L.P., D/B/A AT&T MISSOURI'S
APPLICATION AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

COMES NOW Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") and files this verified Application and Motion for Expedited Treatment, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), and 47 C.F.R. 52.15(g)(3)(iv), and respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue an Order that reviews and reverses the decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator, NeuStar, Inc., ("NANPA") to withhold certain numbering resources from AT&T Missouri, in a form of two 10,000 blocks of numbers to implement the Commission's Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Order Directing Filing, In the Matter of a Request for Expansion of the St. Louis Metropolitan Calling Area Plan to Include the Exchanges of Washington, Union, Wright City, St. Clair, Marthasville, Beaufort, Foley, and Warrenton, Case No. TO-2005-0141, February 23, 2006 ("Order"). In support of its application, AT&T Missouri states as follows:

1. AT&T Missouri is a Texas limited partnership,¹ duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri,² with its principal Missouri office at One SBC Center, Room 3520, St. Louis, Missouri, 63101. AT&T Missouri is authorized to do business in Missouri and its

fictitious name is duly registered with the Missouri Secretary of State.³ AT&T Missouri is a “local exchange telecommunications company” and a “public utility,” and is duly authorized to provide “telecommunications service” within the State of Missouri as each of those phrases is defined in Section 386.020, RSMo. 2000.

3. On December 2, 2005, the Office of Public Counsel (“OPC”), AT&T Missouri, and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Stipulation and Agreement in In the Matter of a Request for Expansion of the St. Louis Metropolitan Calling Area Plan to Include the Exchanges of Washington, Union, Wright City, St. Clair, Marthasville, Beaufort, Foley, and Warrenton, Case No. TO-2005-0141.

4. On December 28, 2005, in anticipation of the Commission approving the Stipulation and Agreement, AT&T Missouri submitted a Thousands-Block Application Form, Part 1A, for the assignment of four 10,000 blocks to implement Metropolitan Calling Area (“MCA”) in the AT&T exchanges of Beaufort, St. Clair, Union, and Washington. AT&T Missouri completed the Applications in accordance with the Industry Numbering Committee’s Thousands-Block Pooling Assignment Guidelines and filled out the necessary Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet for each exchange.

5. AT&T Missouri submitted the request for four 10,000 blocks because AT&T Missouri does not have four 10,000 blocks which could be used to provide MCA service in these exchanges.

6. On or about December 28, 2006, NANPA granted the request for the St. Clair and Washington exchanges, but denied the request for the Beaufort and Union exchanges on the grounds that AT&T Missouri had not met the utilization criteria of 75% as required by the Federal Communications Commission. The following Exhibits are attached hereto:

- a. Exhibit A: Thousand-Block Application Form, Part 1A, for the Beaufort exchange;
- b. Exhibit B: Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet the Beaufort exchange;
- c. Exhibit C: NANPA's decision denying additional numbering resources for the Beaufort exchange;
- d. Exhibit D: Thousand-Block Application Form, Part 1A, for the Union exchange;
- e. Exhibit E: Months to Exhaust and Utilization Certification Worksheet for the Union exchange;
- f. Exhibit F: NANPA's decision denying additional numbering resources for the Union exchange.

7. Under existing procedures, NANPA has asserted that it is required to accept or reject an application for resources based solely on FCC criteria. However, the FCC's March 31, 2000 Order in its Number Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier may challenge a resource denial before the appropriate state regulatory commission and a state commission may choose to reaffirm or overturn NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources.⁴ Thus, the Missouri Commission has the authority to "affirm or overturn the NANPA's decision to withhold numbering resources from the carrier based on its determination of compliance with the

reporting and numbering resource application requirements herein.”⁵ Moreover, the FCC gave the states the flexibility to direct NANPA to assign additional numbering resources to carriers that have demonstrated a verifiable need.⁶ The FCC recognized that in many instances, the failure to address a request for additional numbering resources can impair a carrier’s ability to stay in or expand business.⁷ Although the FCC declined to establish a specific timeframe for states to act on these requests, the FCC indicated “in most instances, 10 business days from receipt of request that the state determines to be sufficiently detailed and complete will be sufficient time to review and act upon safety valve requests.”⁸

8. AT&T Missouri seeks the Commission’s direction to overturn NANPA’s decision to withhold numbering resources. This Commission has previously overturned NANPA’s decision to withhold numbering resources in the following cases: (1) Order Granting Additional Numbering Resources, In the Matter of the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, for Review and Reversal of North American Numbering Plan Administrator’s Decision to Withhold Numbering Resources, Case No. TO-2006-0231, December 13, 2005; (2) Order Reversing Decision of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator and Closing Case, In the Matter of the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, for Review and Reversal of North American Numbering Plan Administrator’s Decision to Withhold Numbering Resources, Case No. TO-2005-0406, May 26, 2005; (3) Order Granting Additional Numbering Resources, In the Matter of the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, for Review and Reversal of the North American Numbering Plan Administrator’s Decision to Withhold Numbering

Resources, Case No. TO-2005-0312, April 19, 2005; (4) Order Granting Additional Numbering Plan Resources, In the Matter of the Application of Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri, For Review and Reversal of North American Numbering Plan Administrator's Decision to Withhold Numbering Resources, Case No. IO-2003-0318, April 1, 2003; (5) Order Granting Additional Numbering Resources, In the Matter of the Application of GTE Midwest Incorporated, d/b/a Verizon Midwest for Review and Reversal of North American Number Plan Administrator's Decision to Withhold Numbering Resources, Case No. TO-2002-481, June 2, 2002.

9. AT&T Missouri does not have any pending or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment, or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.


10. AT&T Missouri does not have any annual report or assessment fees that are overdue in Missouri.

11. AT&T Missouri asks that the Commission act on this request within ten (10) business days as envisioned by the FCC. In order to implement the Commission's Order by October 30, 2006, AT&T Missouri needs additional numbering resources in the Beaufort and Union exchanges no later than the end of March.

WHEREFORE, AT&T Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission overturn NANPA's previous determination in this matter within ten business days as envisioned by the FCC, and instruct NANPA to release the numbering resources necessary to implement the Commission's Order.
