





I would like to address the proposed Grain Belt Express Transmission Line to be constructed through northern Missouri that is before the Public Service Commission for consideration. As a landowner myself, I believe the practice of eminent domain should be used as sparingly as possible. This project is not aimed to utilize Missouri producers or provide for Missouri consumers, and I do not find a compelling interest for our citizens to support it.
