On February 20, 2015, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") asked the Commission to either find that it does not have jurisdiction over this project or, in the alternative, asked the Commission to grant ATXI a certificate of convenience and necessity to build it.

The Commission finds that notice of the application should be given to the general public and interested parties and a date for intervention of proper parties should be set. The Commission's Data Center shall mail a copy of this notice to the County Commission of Marion County. In addition, the Commission's public information officer shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Marion County and to the members of the General Assembly representing Marion County.

The requirement of a hearing has been fulfilled when all those having a desire to be heard are offered an opportunity to be heard. If no proper party or governmental entity is granted intervention, and neither the Commission's Staff nor the Office of the Public

Counsel requests a hearing, the Commission may determine that a hearing is not necessary for a determination on the application.¹


THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
