ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On July 17, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed an Amended Request for Commission Order in which Staff asks the Commission to direct Missouri's utilities, including some of its telecommunications utilities, to answer a series of questions about their security preparations. A Commission rule, 4 CSR 240-2.080(13), allows interested parties ten days to respond to any filing, unless the Commission sets another time for response.

On July 27, ten days after Staff filed its Amended Request, the Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association (MCTA) filed a motion asking that it be allowed until August 3 to file its response. The Commission will grant that motion, but will direct MCTA to file its response by 10:00 a.m. on August 3 to allow time for the Commission to consider Staff's motion at its August 5 agenda meeting if it chooses to do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Cable Telecommunications Association's Request for Extension of Time to File Response to Staff's Amended Request for Commission Order is granted and anyone wishing to file a response, or an additional response, to Staff's Amended Request

is allowed until 10:00 a.m. on August 3, 2015 to do so.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
