ORDER DIRECTING STATUS REPORT

The Commission opened this working case at the request of the Office of Public Counsel to consider a rule regarding the reporting of residential customer disconnection data. The Commission initially scheduled a workshop meeting to be held on March 30, 2020, to discuss such a rule. That meeting was indefinitely postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Public Counsel and Staff filed a status report on August 14, 2020, indicating they no longer plan to hold an in-person workshop, and instead are planning a virtual workshop. Public Counsel and Staff asks that they be directed to file a further status report by September 18, 2020, to provide dates and times for a virtual workshop. The Commission will do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff and Public Counsel shall file a joint status report no later than September 18, 2020, to provide dates and times for a virtual workshop meeting.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
