ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR REHEARING

Issue Date October 23, 2007

Effective Date: November 2, 2007

On August 13, 2007, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order setting this matter for an evidentiary hearing to be held on September 12, 2007. With the exception of Marlyn Young, all parties were present. On September 18, under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(3), the Commission issued an order dismissing this complaint. The order was effective on September 28. The case was thereafter closed on October 1.

On October 17, 2007, Marlyn Young filed a Motion for a Rehearing. In his motion, Complainant summarizes the substance of his complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, points out that the Commission failed to rule on Motions for Contempt of Court and states that he believes the Commission was not fair and was unjust in its decision against him.

The Commission points out that this complaint was dismissed because Complainant failed to appear at the hearing. The substance of his complaint in this motion for rehearing is irrelevant. Although it is true that the motions filed by Complainant were not ruled on, those motions actually went to the substance of his complaint and would have been addressed during the hearing.

Section 386.500(1), RSMo 2000, states that the Commission shall grant motions for rehearing "if in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." Complainant has not provided sufficient reason for a rehearing. The Commission will therefore deny his request.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Marlyn Young's Motion for a Rehearing is denied.
2. This order shall become effective on November 2, 2007.
3. This case may be closed on November 3, 2007.
