ORDER CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On November 17, 2008, the Commission issued an order setting a prehearing conference to be held on December 10. Because the company will be in hearings for its pending rate case through December 12, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE, on November 21, filed a motion to reschedule the prehearing conference.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) requires that responsive pleadings be filed within 10 days. More than 10 days have expired and Complainant, Sherrill Fisher, has not responded to the motion. Because there is reason to reschedule the prehearing conference and no apparent reason not to, the Commission will grant AmerenUE's motion.

To facilitate the rescheduling of the prehearing conference, the Commission will encourage Complainant to file a letter setting out dates for a prehearing conference that will be convenient for her. Because the prehearing conference will primarily involve settlement discussions, the Commission reminds Complainant that she may attend the prehearing

conference by telephone. The Commission will reschedule the prehearing conference in a subsequent order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The prehearing conference set for December 10, 2008 is cancelled.
2. Sherrill Fisher may file a letter informing the Commission of dates that may be convenient for her to participate in a prehearing conference.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
