ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

Sherrill E. Fisher has filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE. To move this matter toward its end, the Commission will set a prehearing conference. The parties should be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct and the interval necessary for its completion; the number of witnesses each expects to call at hearing; the number and nature of any exhibits each expects to offer at hearing; and the anticipated length of the hearing. The parties should also be prepared to discuss the current status of settlement negotiations. It is expected that the prehearing conference will provide an opportunity for the parties to further pursue settlement discussions.

If the parties are unable to settle this matter, they shall jointly file a proposed procedural schedule. The proposed procedural schedule shall establish dates for the filing of a list of the issues to be determined by the Commission and statement by the parties of their position on each such issue. The proposed procedural schedule shall also include a

date for the filing of a list of the witnesses to be called, the order in which they shall appear and the order of cross examination agreed upon by the parties.

The proposed procedural shall also establish a date for the hearing. The time for filing the proposed procedural schedule will be discussed during the prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on January 25, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
