ORDER DESCRIBING ISSUES, SETTING ORDER OF PROOF, AND SETTING ORDER OF CROSS-EXAMINATION

The Commission is setting forth the issues as described by the parties. The Commission is also setting the order of proof and order of cross-examination. On October 14, 2011 Staff filed a *List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination* on behalf of Eddie Shepherd and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO").

1. Issues

In any complaint, the issue is whether any conduct or tariff of a public utility violates a statute, Commission regulation or Commission order. Section 386.390.1, RSMo 2000. The parties focus on whether, and if so how much, Mr. Shepherd's meter was inaccurate between a July 2010 lightning strike and the meter's replacement in March 2011.

2. Order of Proof and Cross Examination

The order of proof and cross-examination shall be:

The Commission reminds all parties that the purpose of all evidence is to prove or disprove a claim or defense and that Section 536.070, RSMo, governs the presentation of evidence.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The issues as described by the parties are, and the order of proof and order of cross-examination shall be, as set forth in the body of this order.
2. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
