## ORDER REGARDING SCHEDULE AND SUBPOENAS

The Commission is ordering the filing of proposed procedural schedules and waiving provisions of its regulation on subpoenas. The Commission is sending subpoenas to Mr. Shepherd in blank because Mr. Shepherd is pro se and has already experienced delay in this action. The Commission will waive the following provisions of the Commission's regulation on subpoenas:<sup>1</sup>

(1) A request for a subpoena . . . shall be filed on the form provided by the commission and shall be directed to the secretary of the commission [.]

(4) . . . Blank subpoenas shall not be issued. [<sup>2</sup>]

The Commission is also ordering the filing of proposed schedules. When the Commission has set a hearing date, Mr. Shepherd can fill out and serve the subpoenas subject to
