## NOTICE AND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On August 22, 2011, the Commission received an envelope purportedly from the Complainant. Although the envelope failed to contain a cover letter or pleading explaining the reason the envelope was sent, the contents of the envelope contain what appear to be answers to data requests. Further, the contents contained no mention of an open Commission file; instead, the envelope itself mentioned File No. EC-2011-0247.

As the Commission already ordered on August 16, 2011, and <u>again</u> on August 22, 2011, File No. EC-2011-0247 is <u>closed</u> due to the Commission dismissing Complainant's complaint for failure to abide by Commission orders. File No. EC-2012-0050 is the file open for the above-referenced complaint. On August 22, 2011, the Commission ordered that further correspondence from the parties shall include File No. EC-2012-0050, <u>not</u> File No. EC-2011-0247.

Despite those orders, on August 30, 2011, Mr. Smalls filed a transcript of a criminal case involving wildlife charges, and copies of photographs, in the incorrect case, File No. EC-2011-0247, and not in the correct case, File No. EC-2012-0050.

The Commission will order Mr. Small to state why he has failed to comply with the August 22, 2011 order, and why he failed to give the required ex parte notice about his August 22, 2011 mailing to the Commission, which is imposed by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020. Failure to abide by this, or any other Commission rule, can result in dismissal of the complaint.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Mr. Small shall respond as ordered above, in File No. EC-2012-0050, and not in File No. EC-2011-0247, no later than September 9, 2011.
  - 2. This order is effective immediately upon issuance.
