Farber Telephone Company ("Company") hereby provides notice that it intends to terminate provision of the Wireline Broadband Internet Service (WBAIS) on a tariff basis effective July 1, 2022, at which time it plans to offer permissive detariffed WBIAS on a Title II common-carriage basis pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Federal Communications Commission's Wireline Broadband Order¹. The Company currently offers WBIAS through Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line ("ADSL") Access Service under NECA's Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.

In order to affect the permissive detariffing, NECA will make a tariff filing with the Federal Communications Commissions on June 16, 2022 on 15-day notice to remove the Company from its Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 ADSL Access Services (hereinafter "WBIAS") under the tariff effective July 1, 2022.

Impact on Customers

The only Customer for the Company's WBIAS is the Company's non-regulated Internet Service Provider ("ISP") division. The affiliate purchases WBIAS for use as a component in its broadband internet service sold to end user residential and business customers. The discontinuance of the tariff offering of WBIAS will have no effect on the end user service provided by the division.

Serving Area

The Company's provision of WBIAS under NECA Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 is limited to its ILEC serving area in Missouri in the Farber exchange.

Future Availability of WBIAS on a Permissive—Detariffed Common Carriage Basis

The Company will continue to make WBIAS available on a common-carriage basis. Rates, terms and the conditions of service will be available at the Company's Business Office located at 101 N. Main Street, New Florence, MO 63363 and by telephone at (844) 384-6266. The appropriate information will be displayed at <https://missouricom.co> in a manner similar to that required for the interstate and international interexchange services under Section 42.10 of the FCC's rules (47 C.F.R. § 42.10.)
