NOTICE OF NON-OBJECTION TO STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) and, as represented in footnote 1 of the nonunanimous stipulation and agreement between Union Electric Company, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Renew Missouri Advocates, the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy, and the Missouri Department of Conservation filed July 31, 2019, the OPC does not object to that agreement.

Because the nonunanimous stipulation and agreement includes the following, “The Signatories agree that they shall not challenge the prudence of the decision to construct the facility for RES compliance purposes under Section 393.1030, RSMo., and to merge Outlaw Wind Project, LLC into Ameren Missouri upon acquisition of the facility,” and prudence of constructing facilities may change before they are built—Union Electric Company’s July 25, 2019, announcement of its mutual agreement with EDF Renewables, Inc. to terminate the development of the Brickyard Hills 157 megawatts (MW) wind facility in Atchison County after the Commission, in Case No. EA-2019-0021, granted Union Electric Company a certificate of convenience and necessity for that facility on March 16, 2019, is a good example—the OPC did not sign the nonunanimous stipulation and agreement.
