West's application is signed by Ms. Thomas, who does not identify herself as an attorney licensed to practice in Missouri and is obviously acting on behalf of the corporation rather than as a natural person or as the individual owner of West.

West's filing is deficient and the Commission will not take action on this application until this deficiency is corrected. The Commission will leave the file open

until May 31, 2012, to allow West to correct the deficiency. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
