On May 11, 2012, West IP Communications, Inc. filed an Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission for registration to offer and provide statewide interconnected voice over Internet service.

The Application filed by West did not contain an attorney's signature licensed to practice law in Missouri or any other state, but was signed by Sharon Thomas, identified as West's Consultant. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.040(5), pleadings filed with the Commission must be signed by at least one attorney of record authorized to practice law in Missouri.

On May 16, 2012, the Commission issued a Notice of Deficiency allowing the company to correct the deficiency by May 31, 2012. No response was filed. Thus, the Application filed on May 11, 2012, is rejected by the Commission and this case will be closed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application filed by West IP Communications, Inc. on May 11, 2012, is rejected.
2. This case may be closed.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
