ORDER DISMISSING MOTION FOR PROPOSED RULEMAKING AS MOOT

On December 19, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel, Praxair, Inc., AG Processing, Inc., the Midwest Gas Users Association, the Sedalia Energy Users Association, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the Missouri Energy Group, AARP, and the Consumers Council of Missouri jointly filed a motion asking the Commission to make changes to Commission regulation 4 CSR 240-4.020, which concerns conduct during Commission proceedings.

The Commission collected comments about the proposed rulemaking from interested members of the public, but took no direct action on the motion. Instead, the Commission commissioned an independent study of its code of conduct and ethics rules. As a result of that study, the Commission promulgated a revised standards of conduct rule that was published in the Missouri Register as a final Order of Rulemaking on June 1, 2010.

The Commission has now addressed the substance of the motion for proposed rulemaking, rendering the motion moot. Therefore, the Commission will dismiss the motion and close this file.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Proposed Rulemaking filed on December 19, 2007, is dismissed as moot.

 - 3. This file shall be closed on June 20, 2010.
