COMES NOW Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Elm Hills), and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), moves the Commission for expedited treatment of Elm Hills' tariff sheets filed on October 15, 2018:

1. The transactions that are the subject of the Commission's Order Granting

Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and Granting Waiver could close as soon as October 31, 2018.

2. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, Elm Hills has filed sewer tariff sheets consistent with the Commission's *Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and Granting Waiver*. These tariff sheets carry proposed effective dates of November 14, 2018 (30 days), and have been assigned tracking number YS-2019-0065. A list of the filed tariff sheets is attached hereto as **Appendix A**. The tariff sheets are also provided with this Motion.

3. Elm Hills hereby seeks the Commission's order allowing the proposed tariff sheets to go into effect on less than thirty days notice, as of October 31, 2018.

4. A grant of this motion will further the public interest. The subject transactions could close as soon as October 31, 2018. As of that date, Elm Hills may own and operate one, or both, of the subject systems. The subject tariff sheets are intended to clarify the rates, rules and regulations that will apply to the subject customers on a going-forward basis. Addressing these

tariff sheets in an expedited manner will eliminate or reduce any gap that might exist in regard to these subjects.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Elm Hills respectfully requests the Commission grant this Motion for Expedited Treatment and approve Elm Hills' proposed tariff sheets (YS-2019-0065) to be effective on October 31, 2018, or as soon thereafter as the Commission has the opportunity to address this matter.
