Cooperative, hereinafter referred to collectively as "Applicants", by and through their

Response to the Missouri Public Service Commission Order issued on December 9, 2003,

state as follows:

1. On December 9, 2003, the Commission issued an Order granting the Applicants Joint Motion for Waiver of Commission Order to Provide Customer Notification, and directing the Applicants to provide notice to all other electrical suppliers serving any part of the Counties affected by the Applicants' territorial agreement within ten days of the effective date of the Commission's Order. The Commission stated:

Staff further pointed out that the Joint Applicants had not filed proof of service on the other electrical suppliers serving the territory covered by the proposed territorial agreement as required by Section 394.312.3, RSMo 2000. Staff suggest that such proof of service be filed.

- 2. To clarify that the Applicants did not intentionally overlook any filing requirements, the Applicants point out that there are currently no requirements for direct notice to be sent to other service providers under the Commission's rules. The Missouri statute, 394.312.3, RSMo 2000, states, "Applications for commission approval shall be made and notice of such filing shall be given to other electrical suppliers *pursuant to the rules and regulations of the commission governing applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity.*" The Commission's rules governing applications for certificates of public convenience and necessity, 4 CSR 240-2.060(4) and 4 CSR 240-3.105, do not require applicants to provide notice to other electrical suppliers. Nor is such notice required in the Commission's rules pertaining to territorial agreements: 4 CSR 240-2.060(13), and 4 CSR 240-3.130.
- 3. Applicants attach hereto copies of the letters mailed on December 12,2003 to the other electrical suppliers.




