2. Mr. Johnstone is President of Competitive Energy Dynamics, L.L.C. and consultant in the field of public utility regulation.

Mr. Johnstone received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Missouri at Rolla. After graduating, he worked in the customer engineering divisions of a computer manufacturer. From 1969 to 1973, Mr. Johnstone was an officer in the areas of economic cost analysis, data base design and data processing. Also in 1973 he received his Master of Business Administration Degree from Oklahoma City University. He worked on the peak demand and sales forecasts. From 1977 through 1981, he was Supervisor of the Load Forecasting Group where his responsibilities included the Company's sales and peak demand forecasts and the weather normalization of sales. In 1981, he began consulting, and in 2000, he created the firm Competitive Energy Dynamics, L.L.C. As a part of thirty years of consulting practice, Mr. Johnstone has participated in the analysis of various electric, gas, water, and sewer utility matters, including the analysis and preparation of cost-of-service studies and rate analyses. In

addition to general rate cases, Mr. Johnstone has participated in electric fuel and gas cost reviews and planning proceedings, policy proceedings, market price surveys, generation capacity evaluations, and assorted matters related to the restructuring of the electric and gas industries. He has also assisted companies seeking locations for new manufacturing facilities.
