The Commission is giving notice of a contested case and ordering responses.

On October 9, 2014, the complainant filed the complaint. For any formal complaint, the Commission's regulations provide:

Upon the filing of a complaint in compliance with these rules, the secretary of the commission shall serve by certified mail, postage prepaid, a copy of the complaint upon the person, corporation or public utility against whom the complaint has been filed, which shall be accompanied by a notice that the matter complained of be satisfied or that the complaint be answered by the respondent, unless otherwise ordered, within thirty (30) days of the date of the notice. This is a contested case. A contested case is a formal hearing procedure, including discovery, for which the provisions are set forth at Commission Regulation 4 CSR 240-2.090. But contested case procedure allows for waiver of procedural formalities and a decision without an evidentiary hearing, including by stipulation and agreement.³ Also, as an alternative to the formal evidentiary hearing procedure, the Commission offers mediation. Mediation is a voluntary process in which a neutral person assists the parties in exploring opportunities for settlement. Upon a request for mediation, the Commission may suspend the schedule set forth in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The respondent shall file an answer no later than November 13, 2014.
- 2. This order is effective when issued.
