**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the request of Staff for an extension of time to file a recommendation on the complaint (“motion”).<sup>1</sup> In support, Staff cites the Commission regulation that expressly allows “additional time to complete its investigation for good cause shown.”<sup>2</sup> Good cause means a good faith basis for reasonable relief.<sup>3</sup> In the motion, Staff states why a fully developed recommendation requires further investigation, which constitutes good cause. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The motion is granted.
2. Staff’s recommendation is due on August 24th, 2015.
