**ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

The Commission held a prehearing conference on July 28, 2023. At that prehearing conference, the Regulatory Law Judge informed the parties he would issue a procedural schedule with an evidentiary hearing on August 30, 2023. Accordingly, the Commission issues the following procedural schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The following procedural schedule is established:

<b>Discovery Deadline</b>	August 15, 2023 <sup>1</sup>
<b>Evidentiary Hearing</b>	August 30, 2023

2. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled for August 30, 2023, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held virtually by telephone and videoconference via WebEx. WebEx meeting information will be emailed to the parties prior to the evidentiary hearing. 3. The parties shall comply with the following additional procedural requirements:

A. The requirement that parties seek a telephone conference with the presiding officer before filing a discovery motion shall not apply for this complaint. If a party has already conferred or attempted to confer with opposing counsel or a party concerning a discovery matter, that party may file a discovery motion for the Commission's consideration. Any discovery motion may be ruled upon by the presiding Regulatory Law Judge.
