Pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-20.090(4) of the regulations of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("KCP&L-GMO" or the "Company") hereby submits proposed rate schedules to adjust charges related to the Company's approved Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC"). The proposed rate schedules bear an issue date of December 23, 2009, and an effective date of March 1, 2010.

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FAC includable costs for the six month period ending November 30, 2009, have increased by approximately \$24 million above the base costs included in rates. In accordance with the FAC for KCP&L-GMO approved by the Commission, the proposed rate schedules are designed to recover from customers 95 percent of those net cost increases. The requested increase will result in an increase to a typical residential customer's bill of approximately \$0.65 per month for MPS and a decrease of approximately \$1.80 per month for L&P.

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KCP&L-GMO increased the non-FAC rates effective September 1, 2009. This current filing is for fuel related costs only. As explained in the Direct Testimony and supporting schedules of Tim Rush, which are submitted concurrently herewith, the major factors that have caused the proposed increases in FAC-related charges are: (i) higher natural gas costs; (ii) higher purchased power costs; and (iii) higher coal and freights costs. Also provided herewith are schedules containing the information required by 4 C.S.R. 240-3.161(7), including all workpapers that support the proposed rate schedules.

Copies of the proposed FAC-related rate schedules and all supporting materials described in this letter will be served electronically, this date, on the Commission's General Counsel, the Office of Public Counsel, and each party to Case No. ER-2009-0090.
