**Re: CONTAINS NON-PUBLIC INFORMATION  
Cable One, Inc. Statement of Revenue for Calendar Year 2018**

To Whom It May Concern:

Cable One, Inc. ("Cable One") respectfully submits the enclosed Statement of Revenue for calendar year 2018 ("Revenue Statement"). Per the instructions to the Revenue Statement, Cable One understands its Revenue Statement will be treated as confidential pursuant to Section 386.480 RSMo. Nonetheless, Cable One requests confidential treatment of its Revenue Statement pursuant to Section 240-2.135(2) of the Commission's rules, and asks the Commission to afford confidential treatment to the Revenue Statement.

The revenue information set forth in the Revenue Statement is "market-specific information" relating to the interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol ("VoIP") service Cable One provides in Missouri, which is "offered in competition with others" in Missouri (paragraph 3 of Rule 2.135(2)(A)). Further, the revenue information qualifies as "trade secrets" under Section 417.453 RSMo as it has "independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to, and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use" and Cable One takes reasonable efforts to maintain its secrecy (paragraph 8 of Rule 2.135(2)(A)). While Cable One is a publicly-traded company, it does not report its revenue derived from the provision of interconnected VoIP service in Missouri in any public record in the format requested by the Revenue Statement. Accordingly, Cable One's Revenue Statement has been marked as CONFIDENTIAL pursuant to Rule 2.135(2) and the accompanying Affidavit.

In the event this request is denied, please provide the undersigned with notice of that determination prior to making the confidential revenue information available to the public. Cable One further requests that the Commission stay the release of the confidential revenue information until such time as an application for review of the determination is resolved. Disclosure of the confidential information without affording Cable One an opportunity to contest a finding against confidentiality would prejudice Cable One and render moot any successful appeal.

4. The revenue information in the Revenue Statement is not available to the public in any format. While Cable One is a publicly-traded company, it does not report its revenue derived from the provision of interconnected VoIP service in Missouri in any public record.
