**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY DATE BY WHICH**  
**UPDATED TARIFF SHEETS MUST BE FILED**

On March 28<sup>1</sup>, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (hereafter “AmerenUE”) and Pemiscot-Dunklin Electric Cooperative, Inc. (hereafter Pemiscot-Dunklin), submitted to the Commission a Joint Application. The joint applicants want to transfer approximately 2,700 Dunklin County customers from AmerenUE to Pemiscot-Dunklin. To accomplish such a transfer, the joint applicants sought Commission approval of their request for a change in the electric supplier for those customers, approval for the sale of certain AmerenUE assets to Pemiscot-Dunklin, and approval of a territorial agreement between the applicants.

After receiving a favorable Staff Recommendation, the Commission granted the applicants' request in a June 24 Report and Order. That order required AmerenUE to file updated tariff sheets to reflect its change in service territory no later than July 24.

On September 12, AmerenUE filed a Motion to Modify Date By Which Updated Tariff Sheets Must Be Filed. AmerenUE explains that no structures have yet be transferred to Pemiscot-Dunklin because AmerenUE is still awaiting Pemiscot-Dunklin to complete construction of a new transmission line. AmerenUE asks the Commission to order it to file updated tariff sheets no later than 30 days after the transfer of customers.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. No party objected to AmerenUE's request. Therefore, the Commission will take up AmerenUE's motion unopposed. The Commission finds the motion reasonable, and will grant it.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Motion to Modify Date By Which Updated Tariff Sheets Must Be Filed is granted.
2. Union Electric Company d/b/a/ AmerenUE shall filed updated tariff sheets no later than 30 days after the transfer of customers to Pemiscot-Dunklin Electric Cooperative, Inc.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
