## ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO INVESTIGATE KCPL'S STORM PREPARATION AND RESTORATION EFFORTS AND SETTING AN INTERVENTION DEADLINE

In December 2007, many electric utility customers in Missouri suffered extended electric power outages as the result of a severe ice storm. The Commission would like to learn more about Kansas City Power & Light Company's preparations for such storms, as well as its response to this storm. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to investigate the effectiveness of KCPL's storm preparation and power restoration efforts and report its findings and recommendations to the Commission.

This is an investigation, not a contested case. However, the Commission will provide notice of this investigation to potentially interested parties and to the public. The Commission will also establish a deadline for the submission of requests to intervene.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Staff of the Commission shall investigate the effectiveness of Kansas
City Power & Light Company's storm preparation and power restoration efforts
regarding the ice storms of December 2007.
