## ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On January 16, 2009, the Staff of the Commission, on behalf of the parties, <sup>1</sup> filed a status report. Staff states that it is still engaged in discovery and is interested in the performance of the KCPL fund for decommissioning costs through the end of 2008. At this time Staff has no indication that the parties will be unable to reach a unanimous stipulation and agreement to resolve all the issues. Staff requests additional time to complete its discovery and to allow the parties to discuss settlement, and proposes that the Commission order another update to be filed no later than February 17, 2009. KCPL and Public Counsel support this request.

The Commission has considered the status report and shall grant Staff's request to set a February 17, 2009, filing date for a further report, a stipulation, or a proposed procedural schedule.
